Janison achieves another global benchmark for Australia's largest national exam

Janison Education Group Limited (ASX:JAN) ("Janison" or the "Company"), is pleased to announce it has successfully completed the online assessment phase of NAPLAN 2022 (the "National Assessment Program – Literacy & Numeracy"). For the first time the assessment was delivered fully online across all participating schools – the culmination of seven years of product development in partnership with Education Services Australia and Microsoft leveraging hyperscale Azure cloud technology.

Janison's assessment software powered NAPLAN Online for the fifth year, across all states and territories in school years three, five, seven and nine. Test statistics this year set a new record for peak concurrent student numbers – believed to be larger than any other online school assessment globally. In doing so, Janison reaffirmed its market-leading position of seamlessly delivering the highest level of security, reliability, and scalable infrastructure for online exams in an equitable and accessible manner for all students.

NAPLAN is the annual nationwide measure which helps parents, teachers, schools, education authorities, governments and the broader community determine whether young Australians are developing literacy and numeracy skills that provide the critical foundation for other learning and for their productive and successful participation in the community.

In the second week of May 2022, Janison's assessment platform delivered 4.3 million tests (over 1 million in a single day) for 1.2 million school students. At its peak, more than 315,000 students simultaneously sat the exam on Janison's platform – seamlessly and without issue.

Over the past few years, there has been a significant investment and uplift in technology capability within schools in order for a transition to online delivery to take place. This includes hardware (PCs and tablets) sufficient to handle a large number of simultaneous students, network capability, and technical literacy among students, schools and teachers. Janison believes this investment and uplift in technology has brought forward the timing of digitisation of other paper-based assessments and paved the way for growth in Janison's assessment product suite and assessment technology platform.

Janison's contractual agreement to deliver NAPLAN Online has been in force since 2017 and remains in place for a further two years, until September 2024. Management is looking forward to working with its partner Education Services Australia to develop future enhancements for the NAPLAN platform and for sustaining a long-term relationship beyond 2024.

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Fig 1. NAPLAN Online 2022: at a glance

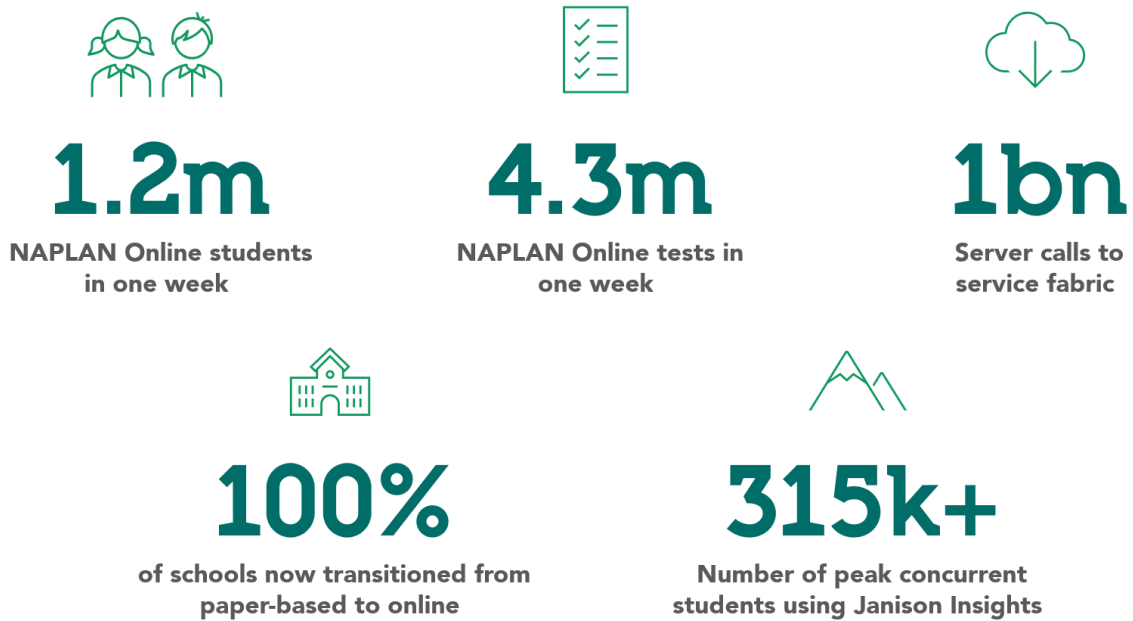
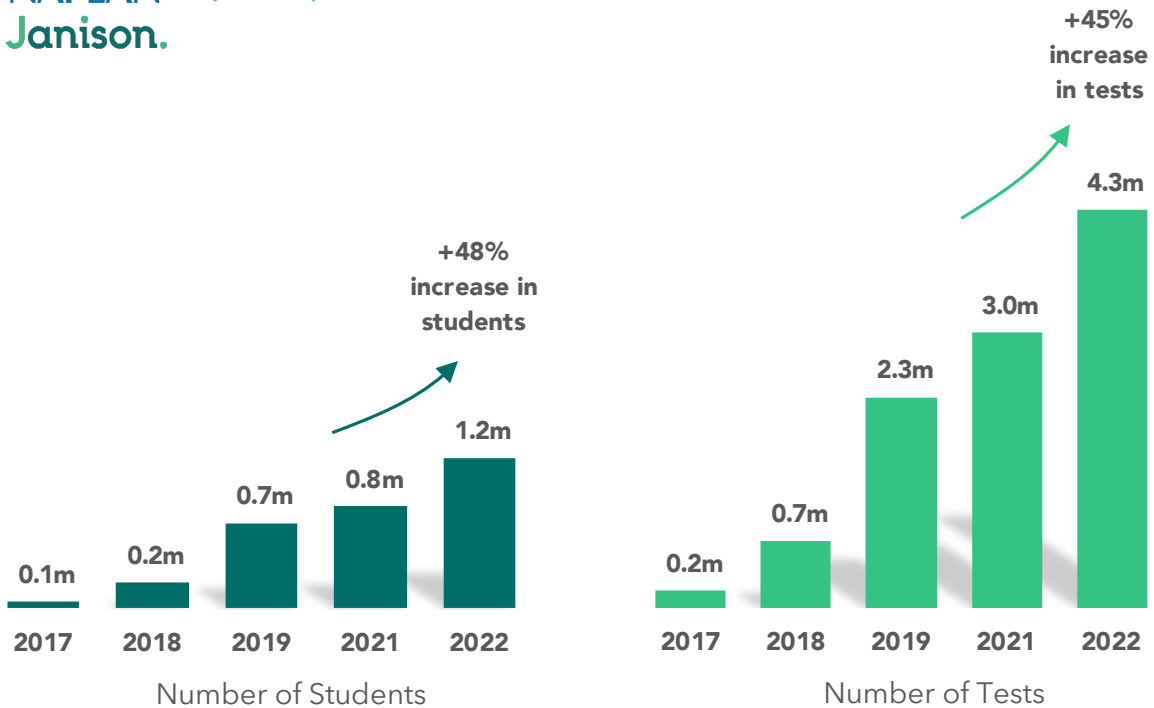


Fig 2. NAPLAN Online: digital transition
